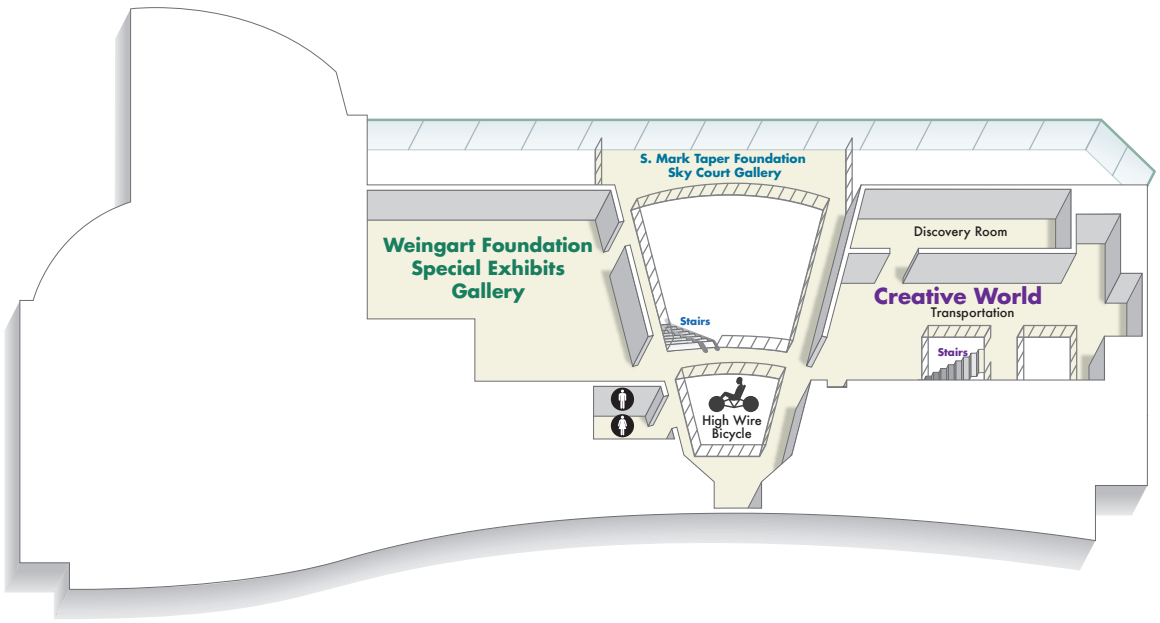

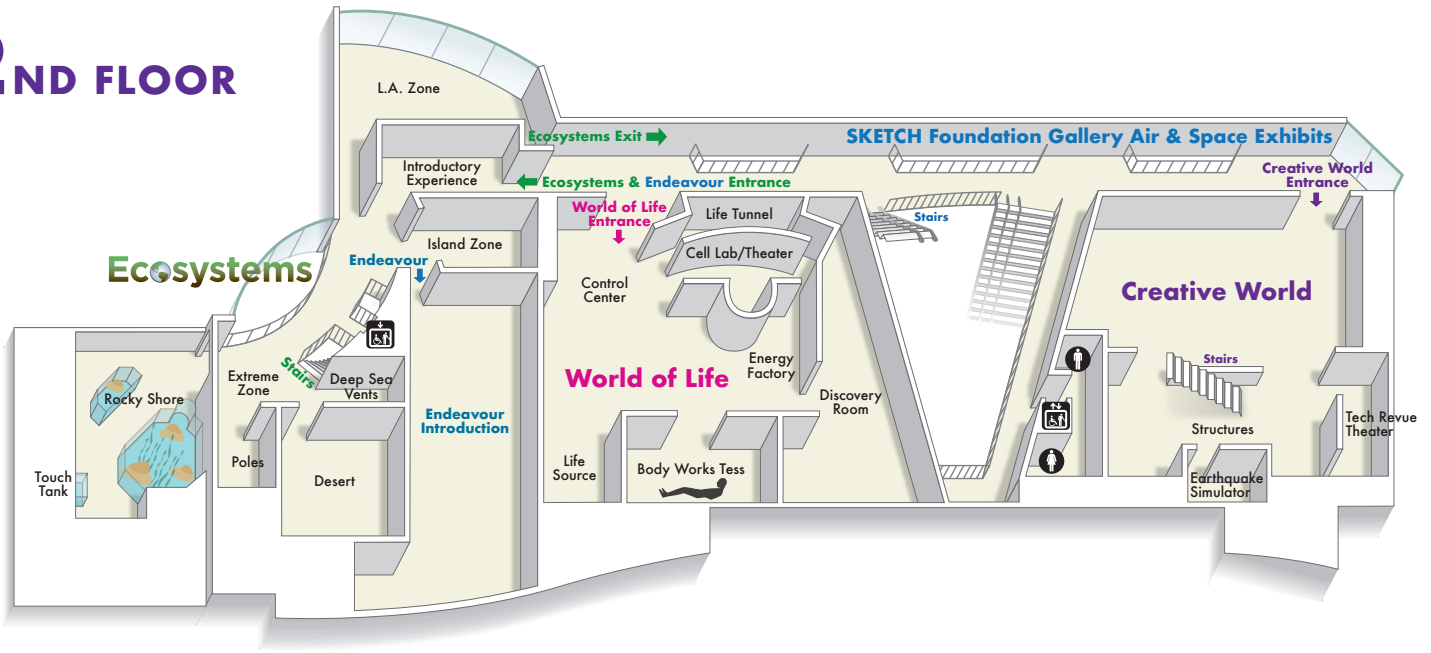
# VISITOR MAP



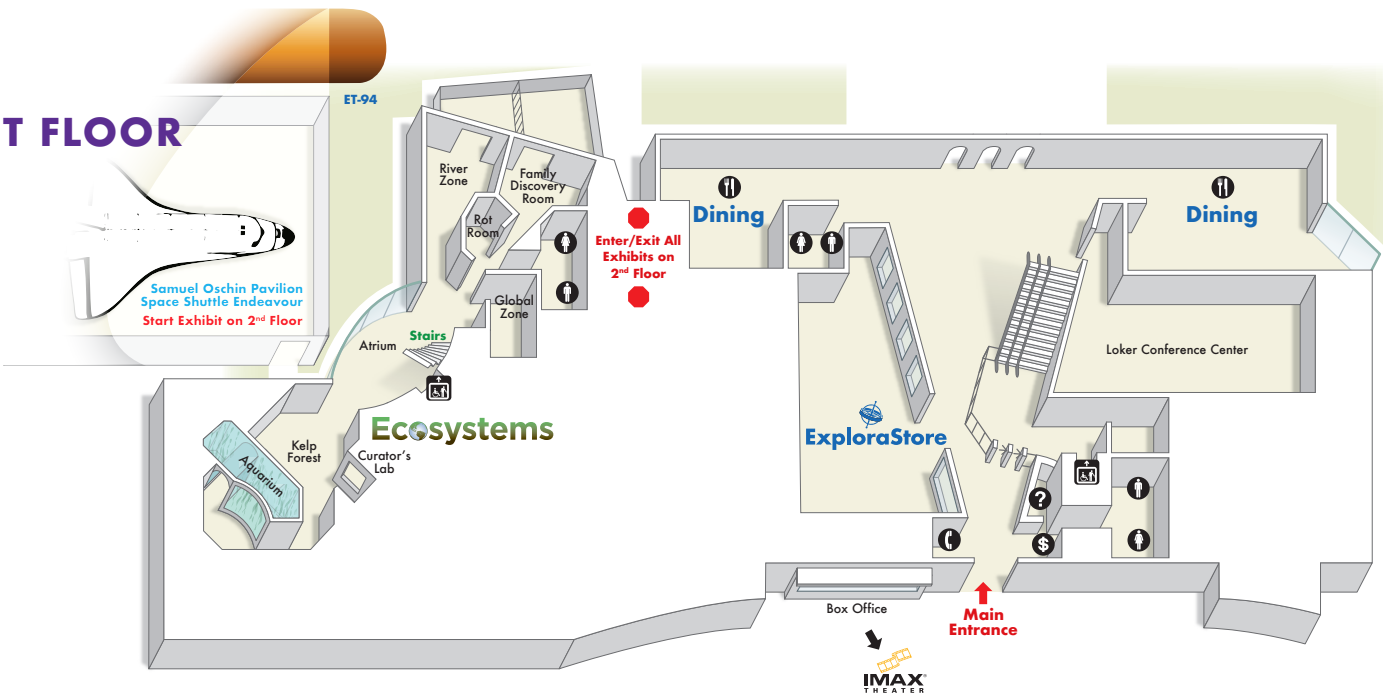
# 3RD FLOOR
